

**Table 3: Confirmation of a Capillary Blood Lead Test for Children**

Capillary Blood Lead Level ( $\mu\text{g/dL}$ )	Confirm with Venous blood lead test with-in:
3-4 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>3 months<sup>1</sup></b>
5-9 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>1 month</b>
10-19 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>1 week- 1 month</b>
20-24 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>1 week</b>
25-44 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>48 hours</b>
45-59 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>24 hours</b>
60-69 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>Immediately</b>
>70 $\mu\text{g/dL}$	<b>Immediately</b>
<b>1. Blood lead levels may vary seasonally and need to repeat in 1-3 months during the summer months when blood lead levels may be higher and repeat in 6 months during the winter months when blood lead levels may be lower</b>
